Principal reason or purpose for rule:

The amendments to Chapter 240 are proposed to update the Standards with which licensees must comply. Effective January 1, 2020 licensees will be expected to comply with the 2020-21 edition of the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice ("USP AP").

Basis statement:

The amendments to ch. 240 update the Standards with which licensees must comply. Effective January 1, 2020 licensees will be expected to comply with the 2020-2021 edition of the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice ("USPAP"). Title 32 MRS §14012(3) authorizes the board to establish standards of practice for licensed real estate appraisers, and 32 MRS §14028 requires licensees to comply with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice ("USPAP), as promulgated by the Appraisal Standards Board of the Appraisal Foundation. This amendment designates the 2020-21 edition of USP AP as the standards of practice in effect beginning January 1, 2020. Changes from the 2019-2020 edition are discussed in detail in the Appraisal Standards Board's "2020 Summary of Actions Related to USPAP Changes" (June 25, 2019).
