This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward for implantable electronic data storage tage and rewards for returned tags for the halibut longline survey. The purpose of this survey is to provide an index of adult halibut biomass as a basis for future assessments. The DST centi-ex archival tags will be surgically implanted into live Atlantic halibut. These tags collect data on temperature and depth at pre-programmed time intervals and can take measurements at depths up to 5,000 feet. The data from these tags can be used to determine where halibut migrate and if, when, and where they spawn. Failure to allot these funds will cause a detrimental impact on the ability to continue to set precautionarily low catch limits, and this could result in lost revenue in our state waters halibut fishery and the broader federally-managed multispecies fishery.
