Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward for general operating expenditures related to ongoing projects. The Natural Areas program provides environmental review, conservation planning services and habitat inventory for multiple organizations. Current projects include ecological inventories including identification and control of invasive plants, ecoreserve monitoring, forest land assessments, and environmental review of projects for the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, and the Bureau of Parks and Lands. Failure to allot these funds will have a detrimental impact on the ability of this program to conduct field work for ongoing projects.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward in the Emergency Response account. These funds will be used to purchase dosimeters that measure radiation levels to avoid emergency public safety worker exposure to adverse levels, analyzers for chemicals and RadEye personal radiation detector. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the Federal Emergency Management Agency regulate emergency planning for radiological emergencies within the Ingestion Exposure Pathway Zone of the Seabrook Station in New Hampshire, which includes most towns in York County. Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the ability of the Maine Emergency Management Agency to fund these activities.


