Statement of Fact

The Department of Education received federal emergency relief funding through Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (CFDA #84.425D) grants in April 2020 and January 2021, and an Emergency Assistance for Non-Public Schools grant (CFDA #84.425R) in February 2021. These grants allow for consolidation of administrative funds to enhance the coordinated use of federal emergency relief funds. The department has created the Office of Federal Emergency Relief Programs to oversee the multiple federal grants received in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Consolidating administrative funds will allow the Office of Federal Emergency Relief Programs to cross train team members between the grants, thereby increasing the effectiveness of the team and expediting response time to school districts.

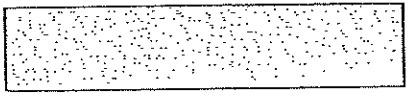
