Topic/Program

• A review of the policies and practices of the Office of Child and Family Services (OCFS) within Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to ensure child safety in the home.

Program Description/Background

• OCFS is responsible for child welfare activities that support child safety, well-being, and permanent homes for children.

Specific Details

• Between May 31, 2021 and June 20, 2021, there have been 4 child deaths in Maine involving children 4 years old or younger.

Possible Areas of Focus Based on Review Request

- Identify any barriers to organizational change in the child protective system and strategies to overcome them.
- Identify and consider more effective ways for the Legislature to provide oversight of the child protection system and assistance to families.

Past or Current Reviews Relating to this Topic
