That the State Controller transfer \$1,431,746 from the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z198-93, CARES Community Mental Health Services Block Grant, to the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z206-93, CARES Community Mental Health, to fund mental health crisis support services; and,
Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller decrease allotment in the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z198-93, CARES Community Mental Health Services Block Grant, and increase allotment in the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z206-93, CARES Community Mental Health, by \$1,431,746; and,
Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022," for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order will provide allotment to fund mental health crisis support services for children and their families when children are experiencing a behavioral health crisis. These services will reduce the number of hours spent in hospital emergency departments and will allow children to remain safely at home with their family. This is an effort to strengthen existing crisis services for children and their families to national best practice standards, by offering clinical support and crisis de-escalation in the family home for up to six weeks. Supplemental funding is provided by the Community Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG) program through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplement Appropriations Act (CRRSAA). This is a grant award that is shared between the Office of Behavioral Health and the Office of Child and Family Services. The full grant award was allotted in error by Financial Order CV0285 F2 to account 015-10A-Z198-93, CARES Community Mental Health Services Block Grant. A portion of this grant should have been allotted to account 015-10A-Z206-93, CARES Community Mental Health.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots \$233,689, a portion of the unencumbered balance forward, and increases allotment by \$80,688 for additional revenue received to pay for criminal background check invoices. The Department of Public Safety bills quarterly for criminal background checks performed on behalf of the Maine Background Check Program. Failure to allot these funds would result in invoices not being paid.

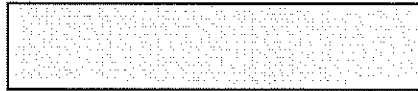

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward to purchase two 40-foot steel storage containers for Department of Marine Resource's (DMR) Watercraft Repair Facility in Rockland. The facility is used to repair and store DMR vessels and other equipment and evidence used or seized by the Bureau of Marine Patrol. The current over 40 year-old shed structure is failing and beyond repair. The Bureau has identified two 40-foot steel storage containers as the most effective replacement for secure and weathertight storage of equipment and evidence. Failure to allot these funds will result in DMR's inability to provide adequate secure and weatherproof storage.

That the State Controller increase allotment in account 014-13A-0027-16, Halibut Fund, by \$6,700 in the All Other line category for the purpose of allotting a portion of the unencumbered balance forward for implantable electronic data storage tags; and,

Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward for implantable electronic data storage tags. The DST centi-ex archival tags will be surgically implanted into live Atlantic halibut. These tags collect data on temperature and depth at pre-programmed time intervals and can take measurements at depths up to 5,000 feet. The data from these tags can be used to determine where halibut migrate and if, when and where they spawn. Failure to allot these funds will cause a detrimental impact on the ability to continue to set precautionarily low catch limits. This could result in lost revenue in our state waters halibut fishery and the broader federally-managed multispecies fishery.
