Statement of Fact

This financial order increases allotment in this Coronavirus Relief Fund account to fund unemployment benefits paid from the State's Unemployment Trust Fund for claimants who lost their employment through no fault of their own as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The funding is no longer needed in the Employment Recovery account, because program utilization was lower than anticipated. Funding is provided by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act.

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order increases allotment for temporary unemployment assistance benefits provided by federal laws passed as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. This funding is provided by the Relief for Workers Affected by Coronavirus Act program included in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act of 2020 and extended in the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. The CARES Act created the Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) program, which provides unemployment benefits to people who exhaust state unemployment insurance benefits. The program ended September 6, 2021. This financial order covers FY22 first quarter payments that exceeded the initial estimated payment amount allotted on financial order FO CV0270 and payment activity estimated through the end of September 2021 for appeals that are being filed and adjudicated. Failure to provide this allotment will prevent accurate financial accounting for these payments in the State's accounting system.
