The telehealth school nursing model was chosen to expand the reach of school nursing services due to the shortage of school nurses nationwide. The Maine Department of Education (DOE) will administer the telehealth portion of the grant with management and oversight by the Maine CDC. Funds will be used to contract with a telehealth services provider. DOE will provide outreach to eligible Maine schools, coordinate and monitor services and collect service data to ensure compliance with the terms of the grant award.
