#### Statement of Fact

This financial order-provides allotment to enhance the new Comprehensive Child Welfare Information System (CCWIS) platform by adding mobile functionality and developing a secure mobile application. This additional feature will include scheduling, evidence collection, electronic signatures, and access to client records without the need for a computer. These enhancements being added allow for a fuller utilization of available technology platforms for caseworkers. Additional allotment is needed to pay projected operational technology costs and STA-CAP. These expenditures are expected to be paid through the Cost Allocation Process. Failure to allot these funds will result in an incomplete utilization of the CCWIS program, will limit the future functionality of CCWIS users, and prevent the anticipated full payment of projected technology expenses.

#### Statement of Fact

Digital cameras are used to document fire investigation (To scenes and will replace existing cameras that have reached the end of their useful life. Line pole surveillance cameras will enable the continuous monitoring of areas that are at a high risk of arson. These expenditures will collectively increase the Fire Marshal's Office's ability to protect against the devastation of fire, explosions, and life safety hazards.
