Overview of recent rate and funding increases for Section 21 providers

- Sizable rate increases for Section 21 providers were included the FY22-23 Biennial Budget (\$26.5 million all funds annually in the baseline)
- On top of these rate increases, partial funding for implementation of 125% of minimum wage and a 2.3% COLA starting July 1, 2022 was included in the biennial budget
- In addition to these rate increases, the Governor intends to request in the FY22 Supplemental Budget to increase the COLA to 4.9%, to accelerate the COLA from July 1, 2022 to January 1, 2022, and to fully fund the 125% min wage requirement
- In total over FY22-23, these new rate increases total \$115 million
- These AAAA rate increases will be applied to rates in place as of 12/31/21, many of which the Department has been updating on the bases of new rate studies and data, at a cadence of every six months, starting in July 2020.
- CMS has already approved all the rates in place as of 12/31/21, including the 7/1 rate adjustments for Agency Home Supports that are the new baseline for the COLA and AAAA rate adjustments. CMS would likely question the use of a rate model that relies on 2007 cost data, especially since its author does not stand by its current use for Agency Home Supports.
