Be it further ordered,

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022," for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

#### Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment to enhance and expand staffing support for in-home vaccine assistance for older adults and people with disabilities, as well as other related program initiatives in their respective communities. Other initiatives will include support of Transition Care which is a solution that takes a whole patient approach in preventing caregiver burnout, enabling in-home care, and allowing care receivers to age in comfort. The new grant award will be distributed across all five of Maine's Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) to enhance and expand wages and benefits for the public health workforce, as well as the costs of associated equipment, training, and supplies for these public health professionals. Funding is provided by the Expanding the Public Health Workforce within the Aging Network for States grant through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

### Statement of Fact

This financial order provides the necessary allotment in account 025-15A-021434, ARPA-MAINE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY to fund emergency preparedness grants to subrecipients from the supplemental Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) Program under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). This provides funding to counties for replacement of existing inoperable generators and/or generators that are insufficient for powering a critical facility. Funds can also be utilized for the purchase of new generators at critical facilities that do not currently possess the ability to mitigate prolonged power outages. These funds were awarded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency with 50% local match by qualified subrecipient counties. Failure to provide this allotment will prevent preparedness costs at the county level to be paid with this funding.
