Require that jails and correctional facilities publicize (or provide upon request) the names and telephone numbers of attorneys whose calls with clients will not be monitored and recorded	
Designate one position on the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy for a defense attorney.	
Request that the Maine Commission on Indigent Legal Services periodically send its list of defense attorneys to the jails.	
Draft legislation that includes a penalty for intentional breach of attorney-client confidentiality	
Recommend that training be provided at the Criminal Justice Academy related to the protection of attorney-client communications.
