Subject: Committee to Ensure Constitutionally Adequate Contact with Counsel / MCILS request for information

This message originates from outside the Maine Legislature.

Good afternoon.

On May 3, 2022, MCILS provided notice of a set of attorney-designated telephone numbers to the various jails, DOC, the Office of the Attorney General, and the Maine Prosecutors' Association, and Securus, all as set out in the attached documents (excluding, from this email, the actual list of telephone numbers). Without ignoring that issues exist with respect to calls made to attorney numbers prior to May 3rd, for our working purposes one significant question is: what happens once a facility has notice that a telephone number belongs to an attorney. To that end, I would respectfully request that each facility provide a response explaining what steps were taken to ensure that none of these numbers were subject to recording. I would further request copes of the system output reports for each number indicating whether each is now blocked; when it was blocked; whether any records of calls to that number exist, including, without limitation whether there are any recordings; and, all logs of all access to that information or those recordings.

Each facility received the call list with my email or correspondence, but I would be happy to provide a new copy should that be helpful. For the reasons expressed by one committee member at the last meeting, I am not including the list itself here.
