Subject: Committee Request: opioid settlement funds

This message originates from outside the Maine Legislature.

Hi Lindsay,

The AG reported that the Committee asked for some figures from the opioid settlements when he presented a few weeks ago. Attached is a breakdown of our first disbursement. As context those settlements are with pharmaceutical distributors AmerisourceBergen, McKesson, and Cardinal and with Janssen (a manufacturer, owned by J&J) – together the Distributor/Janssen settlements are known as the National Opioid Settlements but they are two separate settlements. The first payment from the National Opioid Settlements came from the Distributors' settlement.

We will soon receive a second Distributors payment, which will be roughly the same amount as attached.

We also expect to receive a payment soon from the Janssen settlement – this payment will include front-loaded years of payments because we achieved 100% sign-on of eligible subdivisions and schools. This means that the first few years of Janssen payments will be bundled together and paid in the first year. Therefore we expect this payment to be significant. It also should be understood that because certain yearly payments are front-loaded, later years will see no payments.

We are glad to continue to share figures as we know more.
