Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

‘

Sec. 1. PL 2005, c. 457, Pt. EE, §1 is amended to read:

Sec. EE-1. Transfer from Fund for Efficient Delivery of Local and Regional Services. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5681, subsection 5-B or any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$2,335,918 from the Fund for the Efficient Delivery of Local and Regional Services to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund no later than June 30, 2006 and transfer \$2,451,935 from the Fund for the Efficient Delivery of Local and Regional Services to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund no later than June 30, 2007.’

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. It restores the 2nd year of funding for the Fund for the Efficient Delivery of Local and Regional Services by amending the section of Public Law 2005, chapter 457 that would have transferred the money to the General Fund by June 30, 2007. The amendment also strikes the emergency preamble and emergency clause.
