'Sec. 5 Report; legislation. Resolved: That, by December 15, 2010, the Department of Corrections shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over juvenile justice issues progress on the implementation of this resolve. The Department of Corrections shall include with its progress report proposed legislation necessary to implement the initiatives. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over juvenile justice issues may submit a bill to the 125th Legislature based on the department's report by April 30, 2011.
