Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 10th line (page 1, line 26 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "recommendations" the following: 'with suggested legislation'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 3rd to the last line (page 1, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "February 15, 2011" and inserting the following: 'November 30, 2010'

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 27 to 29 in amendment).

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the reporting date of the Right To Know Advisory Committee from February 15, 2011 to November 30, 2010. It also removes the authorization of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary matters to report out a bill in 2011 and requires the advisory committee to suggest legislation at the end of 2010.
