An Act To Improve the Visibility of Automobiles

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2067, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 249, §1, is amended to read:

C. At any time when ~~windshield wipers are in constant use~~there are atmospheric conditions unfavorable to visibility, including, but not limited to, rain, freezing rain, fog and snow.

SUMMARY

This bill requires that a motor vehicle's headlights must be on during atmospheric conditions unfavorable to visibility.
