An Act To Increase the Redemption Fee on Sorting and Handling Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1866, sub-§4, ¶**A,** as amended by PL 2003, c. 499, §6, is further amended to read:

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1866, sub-§4, ¶B, as corrected by RR 2003, c. 1, §34, is amended to read:

B. In addition to the payment of the refund value, the initiator of the deposit under section 1863-A, subsection 3 shall reimburse the dealer or local redemption center for the cost of handling beverage containers subject to section 1863-A in an amount that equals at least $3 \notin 5 \notin$ per returned container for containers picked up by the initiator before March 1, 2004 and at least 3 $1/2 \notin$ for containers picked up on or after March 1, 2004. The initiator of the deposit may reimburse the dealer or local redemption center directly or indirectly through a contracted agent or through a party with which it has entered into a commingling agreement.

SUMMARY

This bill increases the reimbursement to dealers or local redemption centers from 3ϕ and $3 \frac{1}{2}\phi$ to 5ϕ per returned container.
