Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

## 'An Act To Allow the Electronic Registration of Wild Turkeys'

Amend the bill in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph (page 1, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'**Whereas,** an electronic system is needed to increase the efficiency of registering wild turkeys killed by hunters; and'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "bear, deer, moose or"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1-A in the first line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "bear, deer, moose or"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1-A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "animal" and inserting the following: 'wild turkey'

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "animals" and inserting the following: 'a wild turkey'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. Rules. By April 5, 2011, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall adopt rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 12301A, subsection 4 to establish and maintain an Internet-based system to allow a person to register a wild turkey electronically.'

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment limits electronic registration to wild turkeys and requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to adopt rules relating to electronic registration by April 5, 2011.
