**Resolve, To Require the Department of Agriculture,
Food and Rural Resources To Develop Rules for
the Moisture Content of Commercial Firewood**

Sec. 1 Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to adopt rules.

Resolved: That the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources shall adopt routine technical rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A governing the moisture content of commercial firewood. These rules must include standards for determining whether firewood is seasoned or unseasoned or green based on the moisture content of the firewood.
