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An Act To Remove the Statement of Oral Condition as a Requirement for Denturists Making Partial Dentures

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1100-B, sub-§3, ¶B, as amended by PL 2009, c. 227, §3, is further amended to read:

B. The fitting of a denture to an edentulous or partially edentulous arch or arches, including the making, producing, reproducing, constructing, finishing, supplying, altering and repairing of dentures, without performing alteration to natural or reconstructed tooth structure. ~~Upon the receipt of a written statement of oral condition or oral health certificate as determined by the board by a licensed dentist, a~~ denturist may ~~complete~~perform clinical procedures related to the fabrication of a removable tooth-borne partial denture, including cast frameworks; and

SUMMARY

This bill removes the requirement that a denturist first receive a written statement of oral condition or oral health certificate prior to making partial dentures.
