Amend the amendment in section 1 in §108-B by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 2, lines 27 to 30 in amendment) and inserting the following:

4. Compensation. In the event of a temporary appointment under this section, the commission shall provide administrative support to the temporary commissioner and compensate the temporary commissioner for the hours spent at the commission working on a proceeding at an hourly rate that is computed by dividing the annual salary of a commissioner, established in Title 2, section 6-A, subsection 2, by 2,080 hours.

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies with more detail the compensation that will be provided to a temporary commissioner.
