Amend the bill in the emergency preamble in the 3rd paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2014-15" and inserting the following: '2015-16'

Amend the bill in the emergency preamble in the 4th paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2014-15" and inserting the following '2015-16'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 and 2 and inserting the following:

‘Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
