Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Include the Economic Impact on the State as a Factor To Consider During the Evaluation of Competitively Bid Service Contracts over \$100,000 and Printer Service Contracts over \$5,000'**

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1825-B, sub-§15** is enacted to read:

**15. Economic impact considerations.** The following service contracts established under this subchapter and advertised for competitive bid must include scoring criteria to evaluate a bidder's economic impact on the State's economy and revenues:

- A. Service contracts expected to exceed \$100,000 in total value; and
- B. Printing service contracts expected to exceed \$5,000 in total value.'

## SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It requires the use of scoring criteria on service contracts expected to exceed \$100,000 and printing service contracts expected to exceed \$5,000 to evaluate a bidder's economic impact on Maine's economy and state revenues.
