Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

‘**Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §152, sub-§5**, as amended by PL 1997, c. 776, §5, is further amended to read:

5. Assign new identification number. Assign a new identification number to a vehicle if it has none, or if the vehicle's identification number is destroyed or obliterated, or if the frame, chassis or, if the vehicle is a truck, the cab is changed, or if the vehicle is a reconstructed motorcycle, and shall issue a new certificate of title showing the new identification number upon surrender of the old certificate and completion of an application for title and payment of the fee; and

Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §152, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

6. Other data. Require data necessary on forms, applications, certificates, licenses or other documents; and

Sec. 4. 29-A MRSA §152, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

7. Authorization to operate a motor vehicle. At the Secretary of State's discretion, issue permission to operate a motor vehicle to an individual whose privileges to operate a motor vehicle have been suspended.’

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment authorizes the Secretary of State to issue permission to operate a motor vehicle to an individual whose privileges to operate a motor vehicle have been suspended.
