#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$55,871 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$71,685 in fiscal year 2016-17 to the Regulation and Enforcement program within the Department of Labor for one Labor and Safety Inspector position and related all other costs necessary to enforce the requirement that employers not obtain certain credit information on prospective employees and use that information in the hiring process or decision.
