Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Health and Human Services will require General Fund appropriations of \$643,929 in fiscal year 2016-17 to increase reimbursement for ambulance services to the Medicare allowable rate. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will also be required for the FMAP match.
