Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (3-A) in the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "victim" the following: 'if the crime is committed on or after October 1, 2017'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (5) in the last line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~and~~" and inserting the following: 'and'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (6) in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (7) (page 1, lines 19 and 20 in L.D.).

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (1-A) in the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "victim" the following: 'if the crime is committed on or after October 1, 2017'

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (4-A) in the last line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "victim" the following: 'if the crime is committed on or after October 1, 2017'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment removes from the bill unlawful sexual touching. The amendment makes violations of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 253, subsection 2, paragraph F and section 255-A, subsection 1, paragraphs K and L registrable offenses under sex offender registration laws when those violations are committed on or after October 1, 2017.
