## **An Act To Add Addiction to or Dependency on Opiates or Prescription Drugs to the List of Qualifying Conditions for Medical Marijuana**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2422, sub-§2, ¶D**, as amended by PL 2013, c. 361, §1, is further amended to read:

D. Any other medical condition or its treatment as provided for in section 2424, subsection 2; or

**Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2422, sub-§2, ¶E**, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 361, §1, is amended to read:

E. Post-traumatic stress disorder, inflammatory bowel disease, dyskinetic and spastic movement disorders and other diseases causing severe and persistent muscle spasms; or

**Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §2422, sub-§2, ¶F** is enacted to read:

F. Addiction to or dependency on opiates or prescription drugs.

This bill adds addiction to or dependency on opiates or prescription drugs to the list of qualifying conditions for medical marijuana.
