Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 5 and 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "6 for the period beginning 6 weeks before Easter Sunday and ending 6 weeks after Easter Sunday" and inserting the following: '6'

SUMMARY

Current law prohibits a person from selling, displaying, raffling, giving away or offering for sale to the public any live fowl, turtles or rabbits under 8 weeks of age in lots of less than 6. This amendment removes the changes made to that law by the bill and instead prohibits a person from selling, displaying, raffling, giving away or offering for sale to the public any live fowl, turtles or rabbits under 8 weeks of age in lots of less than 2.
