Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "75%" and inserting the following: '80%'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, changes the amount in the bill that an employer may pay a person who is under 18 years of age to a minimum hourly wage that is 80% of the minimum hourly wage instead of 75% as proposed in the bill.
