## **Preliminary Fiscal Impact Statement**

Little or no savings to State Government Possible savings to municipalities

## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Any state savings from slowing future minimum wage increases will depend on the salary schedules in place at the time the increases occur, but would most likely be minimal, if any.

As with State Government, any municipal savings would depend on the existing rates of pay for employees in each municipality when the reduced increases take effect and on decisions by individual municipalities to react.
