Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph G in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 21 and 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "that are medically necessary"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

‘Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
