## **An Act To Strengthen the Qualifications for County Sheriffs**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §371-B, sub-§3, ¶E**, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 342, §34, is amended to read:

E. The candidate swears to or affirms that the candidate has at least 5 years of law enforcement supervisory employment experience and submits the name, address and telephone number for the relevant employer or employers.

### **SUMMARY**

This bill requires candidates for the office of county sheriff to have 5 years of law enforcement supervisory experience. Currently, the law requires 5 years of supervisory experience generally.
