Amend the bill in section 2 in §2700-B by inserting after subsection 5 the following:

6. Immunity from liability. A person may not be subject to any civil or criminal liability, or to any discipline by a professional licensing board, for any action taken in good faith in accordance with this section.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a provision to protect a person from civil or criminal liability and from professional discipline of a licensing board for actions taken by a person in good faith in accordance with the requirements of the drug donation and redispensing program established in the bill.
