## **An Act To Eliminate Online Burn Permit Fees for All Areas of the State**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §9326, 3rd ¶**, as amended by PL 2017, c. 449, §3, is further amended to read:

A person may apply for a permit to burn using the Internet or as otherwise provided in this article. ~~When a person applies for and is issued a permit electronically pursuant to this section, a fee of \$7 must be paid. From the \$7 fee, \$4 must be deposited in the General Fund, \$2 must be transferred to the municipality in which the permit is issued and the remainder of \$1 must be used to cover administrative costs. For a permit issued in the unorganized and deorganized areas, from the \$7 fee, \$6 must be deposited in the General Fund and the remainder of \$1 must be used to cover administrative costs.~~

### **SUMMARY**

This bill eliminates online burn permit fees for all areas of the State.
