Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill provides a sales tax exemption for sales to career and technical student organizations and would result in a reduction in General Fund revenue of \$1,330 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$1,957 in fiscal year 2020-21. It would also result in a reduction in Local Government Fund revenue of \$70 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$103 in fiscal year 2020-21. The Department of Administrative and Financial Services will require a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$5,000 in fiscal year 2019-20 for computer programming costs to create an exemption certificate.
