#### Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements

Reductions in the collection of fines related to those cases where the class of crime is decreased from Class E to a traffic violation will decrease General Fund or other dedicated revenue by minor amounts.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Judicial Department will require a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$1,500 in fiscal year 2023-24 for computer programming costs to update the classification of offenses.
