Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements

There may be a minor reduction of workload associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system.

A reduction in fine revenue associated with increasing the allowable duration of an exemption from seat belt requirements for persons with a medical condition will decrease General Fund and other dedicated revenue by minor amounts.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes a one-time Highway Fund allocation of \$10,387 to the Department of the Secretary of State to modify information technology systems.
