Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill establishes the Recovery Community Centers Fund (RCCF) within the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Behavioral Health to fund recovery community centers. It establishes a \$2,000,000 per year statutory transfer beginning July 1, 2025 from the Adult Use Cannabis Public Health and Safety and Municipal Optin Fund to the RCCF. It provides a baseline allocation of \$500 beginning in fiscal year 2024-25 to allow for expenditures from the fund for recovery community centers in the event that other source funds are received prior to the start of the statutory transfers.
