## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The Department of Health and Human Services will require General Fund appropriations of \$136,568 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$141,996 in fiscal year 2026-27 to establish two positions in the Office of Child and Family Services - Central Office program to implement and enforce criminal background checks for child dance class instructors. Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$55,955 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$58,179 in fiscal year 2026-27 will also be required for these positions.
