## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The Department of Public Safety will require a General Fund appropriation of \$56,291 and a Highway Fund allocation of \$30,310 in fiscal year 2025-26 and a General Fund appropriation of \$58,062 and a Highway Fund allocation of \$31,264 in fiscal year 2026-27 for one Office Associate II position and related costs to establish and maintain a publicly accessible website that lists all missing persons in the state.
