Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill extends deadlines related to the reuse and recycling of construction and demolition debris, allowing oversized bulky waste to continue being accepted at the current tipping fee of \$2 per ton until July 1, 2027. The Department of Environmental Protection estimates that approximately 75,000 tons of eligible waste will be accepted under these provisions, generating an estimated \$150,000 in additional Other Special Revenue Funds revenue in fiscal years 2025–26 and 2026–27. The bill includes one-time allocations to authorize the expenditure of the additional revenue.
