## **State Mandates**

The required local activities in this bill may represent a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. If the bill does require a local unit of government to expand or modify its activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenue, the state mandate provisions of the Constitution of Maine require either: (1) General Fund appropriations be provided to fund at least 90% of any additional necessitated local costs of the mandate; or (2) a Mandate Preamble be added to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt the mandate from the funding requirement. If the bill does represent a state mandate and neither one of these actions occurs, the local units of government will not be required to implement the mandated activities.

## Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Public Safety of \$372,384 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$414,156 in fiscal year 2026-27 and Highway Fund allocations of \$200,514 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$223,007 in fiscal year 2026-27 for one Forensic Chemist II position, one Forensic Chemist I position, two DNA Forensic Analyst positions, one-time costs for a mobile Crime Lab office and related costs to establish, operate and maintain a sexual assault forensic examination kit tracking system, perform an inventory of all kits and develop an annual report on the tracking system.
