#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$49,026 beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 to the Department of the Attorney General to increase the transportation reimbursement rate and to establish a reimbursement rate for employees required to wait for funeral establishments requested to transport a body for the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner.
