**Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The Department of Public Safety will require General Fund appropriations of \$341,666 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$356,214 in fiscal year 2026-27 for 2 MCJA Training Coordinator positions, one Office Associate II position and related costs to develop and implement a nonresidential law enforcement training program.
