Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry has indicated that it plans to seek a combination of Other Special Revenue Funds and additional external funding sources to secure the necessary funds for the pilot project outlined in this resolve.

Any additional costs to the Maine Office of Community Affairs and the Departments of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management and Transportation to coordinate with the department to update flood hazard data within the watershed are expected to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
