Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements

The additional workload associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system does not require additional funding at this time. The collection of additional fines will increase General Fund or other dedicated revenue by minor amounts.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill lowers the age for antique vehicles from 35 to 25 years. The Department of the Secretary of State will require a one-time Highway Fund allocation of \$63,364 in fiscal year 2025-26 for technology costs.
