2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2423-A, sub-§2, ¶C**, as amended by PL 2013, c. 516, §6, is
3 repealed.

4 **SUMMARY**

5 This bill repeals the provision in the Maine Medical Use of Marijuana Act that limits
6 to 5 the number of qualifying patients a primary caregiver may assist.
